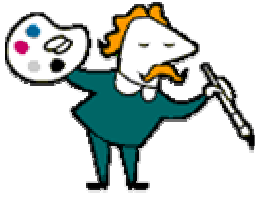


A Chance to be Creative...

Illustrated Classical Literacy

- Select up to two (2) items from the Classical Literacy we have covered in the first semester.
- Illustrate each Classical Literacy item with your own artwork - Be creative! Be artistic! Be colorful!
- Each submission will receive a quiz grade. The grade will be based upon a rubric (*see below*).

THE RULES:

- 1) Each item must be illustrated separately on its own piece of paper. The paper size must be 11" x 14" (half a sheet of normal-sized posterboard).
- 2) The Classical Literacy item must be written on each illustration but not translated or explained -- the illustration should explain the meaning and be appropriate for the item.
- 3) All artwork, drawing, illustrations, and writing must be original and by the student submitting the entry. The artwork must have something to do with the Classical Literacy item being illustrated.
- 4) *All submissions are due to Mr. Keith by the end of the day on Friday, February 20, whether it's an "A" day or a "B" day. Early submissions are always appreciated! **NO LATE PROJECTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
